#### Description

Running libprelude 0.9.15.1 and starting prelude-manager or prelude-lml as

```
prelude-manager -d -P /var/run/prelude-manager.pid  
prelude-lml -d -P /var/run/prelude-lml.pid
```

The PID file always contains 0  
Falling back to 0.9.14 resolves the issue
